- o Bus passes one more year with no cost benefit then plan was to charge \$50 per year to academic students/staff/faculty for use of bus
- Efficiency study vendor has be chosen and ad hoc committee with academic staff representation is being constructed by ASEC
- Badger Partnership now renamed Public Authority Working Group is meeting every Friday to discuss what principles this new system would be designed around
- o Budget TBD, but expect 10-15% cuts in state funding to university

Dean Cadwallader Report – Budget

- 101 money at least a 10% cut is expected and there is a flexibilities question, budget cuts will be spread around
- Human resources system is about 8 weeks out, end of March training
- Rate and title changes are due sooner than later due to new HRS system to be put into place in April, 2011
- Research restructuring
 - o RSP has not moved yet
 - No budgetary impact on centers
 - New industrial contracting unit budget implications on centers should be minimized, this should not come out of center's budget
 - No Graduate School centers shall be moved
- Graduate School Academic Planning Council
 - GS APC is the governance group with voice of Graduate School Centers are having any issues with new VCR/DGS transition
