



## Export Control-Project Assessment Process

### When?

- The process was rolled out in WISPER on June 10, 2013.

### Why?

- The federal government has regulations to control the transfer of items, information, data, software and technology to foreign persons and organizations.
- Export licenses are required for items on the Commerce Control List (CCL, 15 CFR 774) and the US Munitions List (ITAR, 22 CFR 120-130). Ex: pathogenic biological agents, satellite technology, encryption software, focal plane arrays.
- A license may also be necessary if a foreign person is working on a project in the US or receives controlled information within the US. This is called as a “deemed export.” The requirements for deemed export vary depending on the type of project and the country of origin of the foreign person(s).

### What?

- Under the WISPER General Tab, Compliance Question 8 reads: *Does the project involve research or services in a scientific, engineering or technology field?*
  - No = done with export control assessment
  - Yes = answer follow up questions on the Projects Tab, if project is awarded
    - If yes, you will have to answer two additional questions:
      - Does the project include *Controlled Technology*?
      - Is an *Export or Deemed Export* planned as part of this project?
        - If Yes to both questions = complete Export Control Assessment form
- The Export Control Assessment (ECA) is a form with 9 yes or no questions to determine if an export license will be needed.

  - It is the PI's responsibility to complete the ECA and then forward it to the Export Control Office for review.
- If you are unsure about the WISPER questions and/or the ECA, please contact the Export Control Office as noted below.

**NOTE: Answering yes to any of the WISPER questions will not prevent you from submitting a proposal or setting up an award.**
