Potential Outcomes of Full Assessment

License

- Not the end of the world
- We submit ~6 licenses per year
- Typically take 1-2 months to submit and approve (except OFAC)
- Input from project staff; submitted by ExCO

• Technology Control Plan

- Document that describes how the project will be managed from a security standpoint, including personnel, equipment, information, materials and software
- May prevent need for a license
- Developed by PI and ExCO
- Classification of Items/Technology Involved
 - Determine whether items or information are controlled under the CCL (EAR) or USML (ITAR)
- No additional actions





Example 1 – Medical School

A researcher receives an award to study family history and environmental effects on childhood allergies. The study is funded by NIH. Personal and medical information is supplied under a CDA. One of the staff members is a post doc from Spain.

Example 2 – Engineering

An engineer is working on a laser project that could have potential military use. The project is funded by DOD. Two members of the project staff are from China and the Ukraine.

Example 3 – Microbiology

A researcher is studying treatments for anthrax with a collaborator in England. The researcher plans to ship a sample of Bacillus anthracis to England as part of the project. The work is funded by NIH. Publications are planned.

Example 4 – Astronomy

A researcher is developing a guidance system for a sounding rocket. The guidance system is controlled under ITAR. The project is sponsored by NASA who will be the sole recipient of the system. No foreign persons are working on the project.

An archeologist plans to travel to Crete to study the writings on recently discovered ancient Greek tablets. The study is funded by the Smithsonian Institute. She plans to publish the results of her findings.
