



2023-25 Board of Regents Operating Budget Request (in \$ millions)






2023-25 Board of Regents Capital Budget Request

- Engineering Building \$355 Million (\$150 M Gifts)
- Humanities Art Relocation \$144 Million (\$28 M Gifts)
- Residence Hall Renovations \$81 Million
- Camp Randall Sports Center \$299 Million (No State Funds)
- Total for All UW Institutions
 - \$2.5 Billion
 - \$200 Million for Repair and Renovations
 - \$48 Million for Instructional Spaces




UW-Madison will be a market-competitive employer.

SMEs from across UW System are meeting with ATP Design Teams to provide input on high-level business process needs and learn how Workday can meet those needs




Key Outcomes of Stakeholder Activities




Approach

Focus on systems impacted by the retirement of HRS / SFS (PeopleSoft). **Includes:**


- Directly integrated systems (aka 1st hop)
