

## **Motion to Create a New District 401**

March 2001  
Districting and Representation Committee

### **Motion**

**The Districting and Representation Committee moves that the Academic Staff Assembly split district 402, creating a new district 401.**

### **Background**

District 402 has increased to approximately 90 members, due largely to major growth in the staff of the Biotechnology Center.

With this proposed change, the Center for Biology Education (9 people) and the Biotechnology Center (33 people) would move to district 401. The Biochemistry Department staff (46 people) and Enzyme Institute staff (4 people) would remain in district 402.
