

Endorsement of Policy on Misconduct in Scholarly Research

Whereas, the policy on Misconduct in Scholarly Research was originally passed by the Faculty Senate on February 4, 1991, and includes information regarding misconduct by academic staff;

Whereas, a bridging document was passed by the Faculty Senate in March 2008 to address updates in the Public Health Service (PHS) regulations on misconduct;

Whereas, in November 2015 the federal Office of Research Integrity reviewed the UW-Madison Policy on Research Misconduct and bridging document and determined they were inconsistent with each other and with current federal policy;

Whereas, the UW-Madison campus formed a subcommittee to amend the Research Misconduct policy and academic staff were represented on the committee by Heather Daniels; and

Whereas, the revised policy has been reviewed by Academic Staff Executive Committee; University Committee; Associate Deans for Research; Associate Vice Chancellors in the Vice Chancellor for Research and Graduate Education office; and the US Department of Health and Human Services Office of Research Integrity

Therefore, be it resolved that the Academic Staff Assembly endorses the revised UW-Madison Misconduct in Scholarly Research policy.
