

Motion Regarding Academic Staff Assembly District Size Corrections and Districting Logic

The Academic Staff Assembly (ASA) charges the Districting and Representation Committee (DRC) to implement the following rules as needed to ensure ASA Districts comply with District size rules and Districting Logic.

- The DRC will sort academic staff into Districts by giving first consideration to Job Code and second consideration to Division & Department. This will be the ASA's Districting Logic.
- The DRC is granted authority to increase or decrease the total number of Districts, creating new Districts or combining existing Districts as needed to comply with District size rules and Districting Logic without ASA approval. The DRC shall conduct a compliance review of Districts each year during the month prior to elections of ASA Representatives and Alternates.

The DRC is further charged to complete a full redistricting of ASA prior to elections for ASA Representatives and Alternates in April 2017. In this redistricting process, the DRC should uniformly implement Districting Logic and ensure that all Districts comply with size rules.
