

Memorial Resolution for Patrick Mark Heinritz**July 22, 1957 – November 10, 2017**

Patrick Mark Heinritz passed away November 10, 2017, at the age of 60 surrounded by his family.

Pat was the 12th of 18 children and grew up in Appleton, Wisconsin. He received his bachelor's degree from UW-Madison. As many do, he stayed in Madison following graduation and ended up working at UW-Madison for over 35 years. He started his career in payroll and benefits and finished his career as the administrative director of a large multi-city consortium studying inner city asthma. He received the Distinguished Prefix title in 2011 in the Administration Program Specialist title series, becoming one of the few academic staff in administration at that time to achieve this recognition. Pat was active in shared governance during his time at UW-Madison, serving as an Academic Staff Assembly Representative or Alternate for nearly two decades.

He was a passionate supporter of the University of Wisconsin-Madison— so passionate that he met his future wife, Cindy Czajkowski, as he helped recruit her as a new faculty member. He became a dad at the age of 47 to Anne. He loved being a father and spent time with Anne doing everything from cheering her on at swim meets and soccer games to attending a Rolling Stones concert and traveling.

Pat enjoyed sports and, like most Wisconsinites, was a fan of the Brewers, Packers and Badgers. He was an avid golfer and loved fishing.

Pat is survived by his wife and daughter, Cindy and Anne as well as many brothers and sisters, nieces and nephews.
