## Goals for 2015-16

- With DGS, review of Graduate School structure and staffing, and reconceptualize our approach to graduate student funding. This includes working toward providing guaranteed multi-year funding packages for all doctoral students.
- Expand our research funding from federal and non-federal sources, including increasing our share of industry funding. This will be guided by the "Third Way" discussions. A key priority is to use our new seed funding program (UW 2020) if it is awarded by WARF to leverage new federal funding for research.
- Improve campus research infrastructure. Create a community of campus research resources with an inventory of all core resources at the UW-Madison. We need to facilitate increased access, and identify gaps in our research capacity. The goal is to extract greater value from our current core resources and direct funding to filling the gaps and thus make us even more competitive.
- Develop and implement our Washington strategy.
- Support entrepreneurship. This involves enhancing and coordinating the ever-expanding number of campus and related entities in the entrepreneurship ecosystem, including D2P.
