Subject: Hostile and intimidating behavior charge

Ad Hoc Committee on Hostile and Intimidating Behavior

On 3 November 2014, the UW-Madison Faculty Senate passed the University Committee Recommendation to Add Section II-332 to Faculty Legislation Defining Language Describing Hostile and/or Intimidating Behavior (Faculty Document 2511a). Similar legislation was passed by the Academic Staff Assembly on [date]. This shared governance Ad Hoc Committee on Hostile and Intimidating Behavior is charged with developing general guidelines and advice to implement these policies with respect to:

- (1) Determining where formal and informal policies and processes on hostile and intimidating behavior should be housed;
- (2) Developing criteria for what information should be available, in what form it should be disseminated, and where it should be posted; and
- (3) Identifying campus partners and defining their role in informational workshops for new hires and current employees.

Committee recommendations will be submitted to the University Committee by December 1, 2015.
