



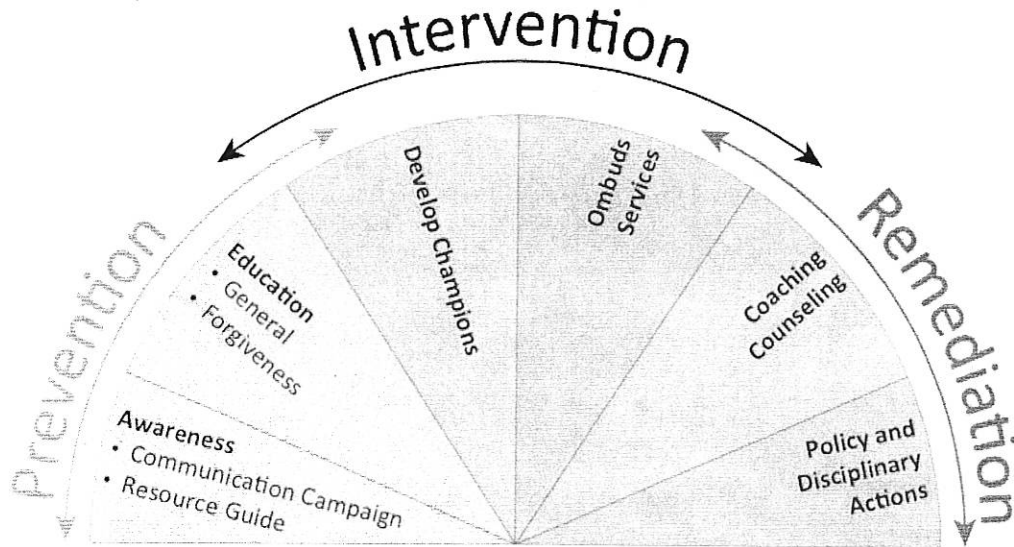
**AD HOC COMMITTEE ON BULLYING RETREAT & RECEPTION**
