Re: Fiscal Year 2018 UW System Administrative Policy Priorities

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide advance notice to institutions of UW System Administrative policies and procedures that are scheduled for revision or development during fiscal year 2018. These policies have been identified as being of high priority, either through the subject matter of the policy, the policy's last revision date, or whether a policy needs be updated due to other internal or external factors (e.g. the recommendations of a systemwide work group). This list is not all-inclusive as other issues may arise as the fiscal year progresses, leading to other policy matters taking precedence. For example, there is crossover between this plan and the fiscal year 2017 policy plan. FY17 policy plans carried over to FY18 are indicated below. Consultation with stakeholder groups will occur as part of the policy development process.

- UW System Administrative Policy for changing fund source of facilities in lieu of a capital project (New)

Information Technology

- SYS 1010, Computing Acquisitions Responsibility and Authority (Revise/Rescind)
 - o Routine review. Policy last revised in October 1997.
