 - 30% turnout (491 total enrollment for First Year Students in CALS/Veterinary)
 - 8% of overall turnout (1,754 ballots)

 - 57 completed ballots

 - 3% of overall turnout (1,754 ballots)

- Engineering
 - 305 completed ballots
