1. Prior to Sept 1: Complete asynchronous Canvas modules
2. Sept 1, 9:30-12:00: Synchronous Zoom session
3. Sept 1, 12:30-5:00: In-person workshops

All new TAs are strongly encouraged to attend. New this year, experienced TAs will access separate Canvas modules containing material geared toward them, and will also have the option to attend the sessions on Sept 1.

Pedagogy Fundamentals for Teaching about Race/Racism

On Sept 2, 2022 (10am - 1pm CST in Union South), the Ethnic Studies Subcommittee will host an in-person training and orientation for grad students teaching Ethnic Studies Requirement courses (both TAs and lecturers). This training is targeted to grad students who are teaching an ESR course in Fall 2022 for the first time, but is also open to grad students who have previous ESR teaching experience. It is focused on establishing a classroom dynamic for promoting respect when discussing race/racism, and teaching to students of both majority and minority identities.
