Dear Colleagues,

I am writing to share with you the projected size of the 2022 First Year class. We are expecting a first-year incoming class of 8500-8700, per projections of our colleagues in the Division of Enrollment Management (DEM). For your reference, the size of Fall 21 first year class was about 8450. L&S teaches 85% of credits that first year students take. Once again, as a collective L&S effort, we will work together to ensure students have access to the courses they need and to ensure that SOAR advising and course registration processes go smoothly.

There is an L&S administration team charged with managing course access as usual. We monitor overall projected first year enrollments as well as specific course enrollments, coordinate efforts with advising units, DEM, and other stakeholder, and our departments. In the upcoming days and weeks I will be in communications with many of you with more specific information and requests.

We have created a Course Access Landing <u>KB page</u> that we will update in the next few weeks as a resource to you. As usual, we will post emails sent to chairs, directors and administrators on the "<u>Communications from L&S Teaching & Learning Administration</u>."
