- i. **Chican@/Latin@ Studies, new undergraduate major:** This is the second stage of creating a new major. The first, which has been completed, is having a Notice of Intent, approved by L&S, UAPC, and Board of Regents. [Proposal](#)
- ii. **Languages and Cultures of Northern Europe, new undergraduate certificate**
New undergraduate certificate that will replace the more narrowly defined Scandinavian Studies certificate. [Proposal](#)
