This will be a research center and there is no intention for the proposed center to offer curricular options, such as certificates. There are letters of support from relevant units. The proposal includes detailed information on how the Center will interact with the Department of History and includes methods to evaluate the Center.

Members discussed the center, letters of support, and how the Center will be funded and interact with other units on campus. SZ and EMK clarified the intention that collaborative work be allowed but that the Center would not be competing with other units for federal funding.

Members unanimously approved the Turkish Studies Center.
